ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED FOR THE POOR & DESTITUTE CHILDREN :-

The organization's prime activity is to work for the Poor & Destitute children. It provides facilities to poor & destitute children of the area to get free education with nutritional support and a proper health check-up. Following programmes were run by the organization during the year 2016-17 for the Poor & Destitute Children of the area as mentioned below:-



A. Health check-up & proper treatment :-

The organization has established its own small health centre. It invites local medical doctors time to time to diagnose the disease if any of these children and treat them. Many a times the organization takes the children with serious cases to nearest govt. Health centres for proper treatment. Sometimes different

specialists are also invited such as Eye Specialist, Dentist, General Physician, ENT Specialist etc. In this year we have treated more than 200 children across our activity area. The children's were also benefitted by the general medicines.

B. Value Education :-

"Jan Kalyan Samiti Chakwaja" is organises non formal education centre (remedial centre) for those children who is not able to get coaching class after school due to lake of money. Now in this centre about 70 children are getting free education by the well experienced and knowledge teachers of the organization.



C. Nutrition Meal programme:-

All the children of the remedial centre are also being served by the nutritional meal. This nutritional meal is being served with the help of SMILE Foundation, New Delhi. The nutritional meal has every day different meal, also seasonal fruit being served to them. All the 70 children of the remedial centre is too thankful for giving them one time meal everyday.



D. Games & Sports :-

The Organization is working in the field of games & sports. It is providing them, foot ball, Cricket, Badminton, Vally Ball & Hockey etc. |

E. Cleanliness Awareness Programme :-

The Organization organized 6 (Four) Awareness Camp for using safe drinking water, to wash their hand with soap before meal, every day bath, to wash their mouth and eyes, to clean toilet, urinal, bathroom and their house.

F. Welfare Programmes for childrens :-

J.K.S.C. is working to provide free distribution of cloths, blankets, copy, books, pencil, pen instrument box etc. for poor & needy Children of the area.



HEALTH EDUCATION & SERVICES

Health is also a prime focus of the organization. Its prime objective is to promote health education to prevent various diseases & to arrange health services to cater the basic health needs of the local poor people who are either very ignorant or unable to pay for treatment. Following activities have been conducted during the year :

A) Medical Relief camp: -

Medical Camps were organized in four different places in Patedhi Belsar in Vaishali District & Kurhani block in Muzaffarpur district. 4500 people were diagnosed & 2000 People were given free medicines collected from different agencies. Many cases have been referred to nearest PHC & district hospitals.

B) General medical camp:-

During the year 1 big medical camps were organized with the support of the Individual Donors & Doctors. All these medical camps were organized at its own Building. Different eminent doctors & specialist were invited to give their service free of cost. As per the registration of the patients 2590 patients, were diagnosed and many of them were given available free medicines & many have been referred to govt. health centres for proper treatment.

C) Awareness programme on HIV/AIDS, T.B., Kala-Azar, Malaria, Fileria, waterborne diseases etc.:-

During the year 10 (Ten) one day awareness camps were organized at Vaishali & Muzaffarpur districts in Bihar on integrated health problems of the area.

OTHER GENERAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME CONDUCTED DURING THE YEAR.

Following other awareness general Programmes were conducted during the year as mentioned below :-

A. Human Rights awareness Programme :-

From the beginning, the organization is working for ensuring basic human rights of the common people. Several activities were conducted during past several years. This year one big awareness camp was organized at its office premises. About 550 villages took part in the camp. Several eminent speakers from Muzaffarpur, Vaishali & Patna were invited to share their views. Besides that several posters were posted to give information to the people.

B. Women empowerment :-

6 awareness camps & five Padyatras were organized to sensitize community to help women to participate in various meetings to lay down their views for overall development of the community. Few meetings were also organized with the in-laws of village women to help the women to take part in the decision making process.

C. Campaign against dowry :-

1 campaigns were organized to aware people to lesson down dowry. In-laws & other male members of the community were invited to discuss on this issue & find a justifiable way to come out of this type of social evil & injustice to women.

D. Old age welfare programme :-

The organization identified 80 elderly people who are either widow, or without wives or discarded from their family having poor economic status. Regular liaisoning with BDO of Patedhi Belsar was done to provide them pension & ration card especially to these who did not have the same. 2 meetings were also organized with these elderly people to know their basic problem. Some elderly people were also given free medical services.

● Child Labour Eradiction Programme :-

It is one of the core activity of the organization. As there are so many Child Labours are working in Vaishali & Muzaffarpur district in Bihar (operational area of this organization), it draws the attention of the organization to work on the issue. As a result several meetings with various stakeholders, awareness camps with the community people etc. Have been organized to reduce the number of child labour from the area. Few list of child labours were given by the organization to concerned District Magistrate to take action against those who are using these innocent poor children in their factories & shops. Some actions were initiated by the district authorities but no such positive change has been observed.

● Cultural Progremme :-

Jan Kalyan Samiti Chakwaja believes that organization of cultural programme is an important tool to bring awareness among the community on different social issues and promote peace and harmony in the society. In the year 2007-08 nine cultural programmes were organized on different social issues like dowry, child marriage unemployment, HIV/AIDS etc. These cultural programmes were performed by rural girls and boys.

- **Relief Opration :-**

The organization is very much concerned for the relief of people who are affected by flood. In, Bihar, where the system is in shambles, poor people have to face a lot of difficulty after the flood. They are unable to get proper food, health facilities and other necessary livelihood items for several months. To fill this gap, **Jan Kalyan Samiti Chakwaja** with its team of volunteers provided flood relief activities in Muzaffarpur and Vaishali districts of Bihar every year. In this year villages were covered with relief activities benefited about 25,600 population.

In the rural area most of the families still lives in huts and cottage. They often face the occurrence of fire problems due to silly mistakes. Due to these factors most of the huts and cottage were burnt in want of proper fire management system. The organization try to help such families during such difficult periods through some relief work like distribution of foods, clothes, Kerosene oil, Plastic Sade, and Medical Service. So about 600 poor families were benefited.

A group of social activists who were highly sensitive to the causes of disparity, Exploitation and poverty turned towards exploring ways to establish a just society in which no one remains unemployed, hungry and exploited. Jan Kalyan Samiti Chakwaja thus got established in 1986. The VISION of the organization is to work for the promotion of a just and equal societies where no one remains hungry, unemployed, uneducated and exploited and the MISSION is to empower rural poor to achieve social justice and self-reliance.
